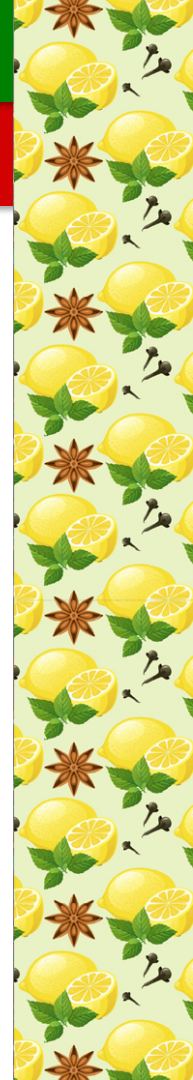
Why Italy?

Country Cons

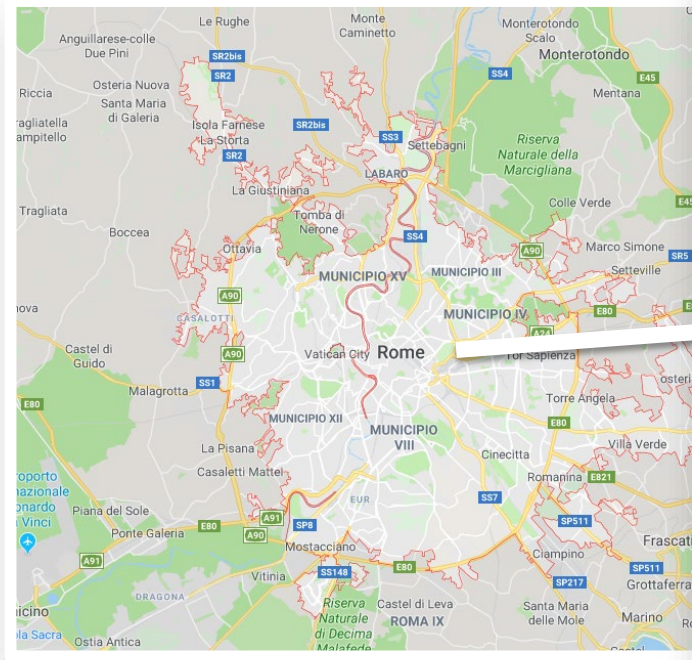
- Bureaucracy—lots of red tape

Noteworthy

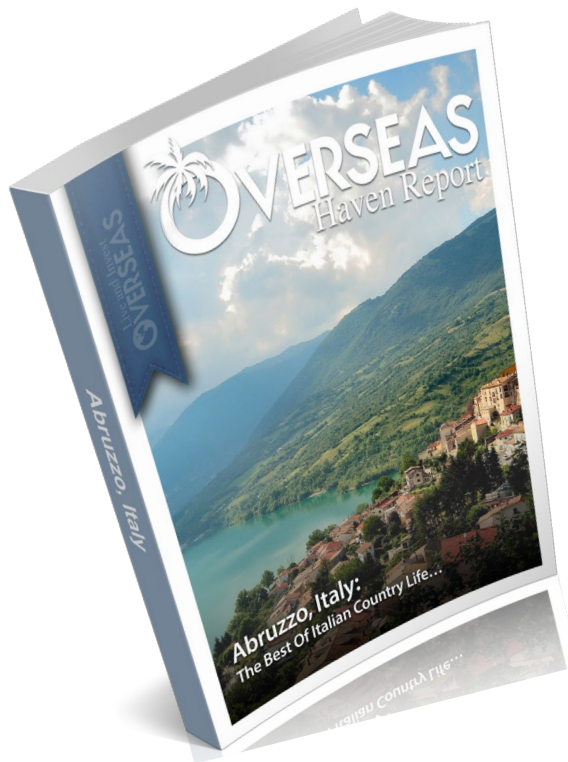
- Highways can be confusing
